*Partisan elections for judicial candidates occur when there are open seats. Judges seeking another term run in nonpartisan retention elections when voters determine by a simple majority (“Yes” or “No”) whether to keep a judge in office. All judicial terms are 10 years except Municipal Court terms, which are six years.

**These partisan positions are elected in the spring Primary Election (fourth Tuesday in April for presidential years and third Tuesday in May for gubernatorial years).
